Fraispertuis-City, the amusement park in the Vosges region, celebrates its **60th anniversary** in 2026! To mark this special milestone, **two new family attractions** are being added to a lineup that already features nearly 40 rides and attractions.

Founded in **1966** by the Fleurent family, Fraispertuis-City is currently the oldest French amusement park still managed by the same family. True to its entrepreneurial spirit and founding values, the park continues to grow through ongoing investment, aiming to offer visitors **unique experiences** and increasingly immersive worlds.

TWO NEW ATTRACTIONS STARTING JULY 4, 2026

Following **nine months of construction** and a record investment of **over €7 million**, a new **1,400 m² extension** is opening to the public. This new themed area highlights a crucial topic: **forest conservation** and **raising awareness about the risk of wildfires**.

Through this immersive experience, Fraispertuis-City aims to pay tribute to the remarkable work of the men and women who protect our natural landscapes with courage and dedication. The attraction draws its inspiration directly from elite American wildland firefighting teams—the **Interagency Hotshot Crews**—who specialize in battling forest fires.

This new area, which also incorporates Sawmill (a 2025 addition), is the result of an ambitious project brought to life through the combined expertise of **local and international companies**: Delot (Anould), BCM (Rambervillers), Laurent Terrassement (Rambervillers), Fusion Nature (Jeanménil), Schoenher et Fils (Raon-l'Étape), Soldel Électricité (Saint-Dié-des-Vosges), TRS (Rambervillers), AEA Élévateurs (Raon-l'Étape), AG Imagineering (Paris), Vekoma (Netherlands), Socrate (Netherlands), Zierer (Germany), Universal Rocks (France/Portugal), RCS Worldwide GmbH (Germany), IMAscore (Germany), FX3 (Belgium), Robers Lighting (Germany), Big Statues (USA), among others.

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FIRELINE REDWOOD



Volunteers are invited to board **Fireline Redwood**, the new "Family Boomerang" **family roller coaster** designed by **Vekoma**. Along a **208-meter track** alternating between underground sections and elevated stretches, riders will enjoy a spectacular experience: a backward ascent to a height of 22.5 meters, followed by a high-speed dash—reaching up to **61 km/h**—toward an impressive **24.5-meter-high spike** set within a fire-ravaged redwood tree. Faced with impassable terrain, the train must then reverse course to return to the starting station.

A **unique ride layout**, created specifically for Fraispertuis-City. It occupies the space freed up by the relocation of a maintenance workshop and the "Joly Jumper" ride. It is the first Family Boomerang coaster to feature an **underground section**. The 20-seat train will accommodate visitors as young as 95 cm (when accompanied) and those 1.20 m or taller (riding alone). Accessibility for guests with reduced mobility has been ensured through the addition of an elevator at the exit and a specially designed car that facilitates the transfer from a wheelchair to the seat.

The attraction features **fully immersive theming**. Beyond the buildings and giant sequoia structures, the area has been landscaped with around sixty trees representing twenty different species. A multisensory experience has been created through **two custom-composed soundtracks**, as well as the addition of **special effects and pyrotechnics** along the track.

Another mission awaits visitors with this 11-meter-tall **family drop tower** designed by **Zierer**.

Stranded atop a tower, two bear cubs frightened by forest fires need the bravest visitors to come to their rescue. A family adventure full of twists and turns.

Accessible to children as young as **95 cm tall** (when accompanied), this attraction enhances the park's family offerings by providing a shared experience. Serving as a new stepping stone between the gentle thrills of the Joly Jumper and the big drop of the Cactus, the tower also offers a panoramic **360° view** of the entire new zone.



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
